
In a job already or looking for work?

Can we help you?

Our broad eligibility criteria allows us to work with lots of different people.

We do our best to provide advice to everyone who contacts us, but to benefit from our full range of employment support, you should meet the eligibility criteria below;

Aged between 14 and 65

- ✓ Octavia tenant or resident in Kensington & Chelsea, Westminster, Hammersmith & Fulham or Brent
- Unemployed, in low paid full-time employment* or employed part-time**
- Currently studying part-time up to 16 hours per week
- British citizen or have the right to work in the UK***
- * People in employed should be receiving minimum wage.

** People in part-time employment should be employed up to 16 hours per week.

*** You may register for employment support if your application for indefinite leave to remain is being processed by the Home Office.
