Incident: Flood – post severe weather conditions 12 July 2021

As a result of severe weather conditions which resulted in localised flooding across London yesterday, Kensington and Chelsea Council declared an emergency situation at 7pm on Monday 12 July. The flooding has impacted parts of North Kensington and the Council is providing support to all of those affected, including residents and our local businesses.

Last night, Council officers attended locations across the area with London Fire Brigade and Metropolitan Police to evacuate residents and ensure property was safe. The Curve Community Centre (10 Bard Road, W10 6TH) is open today until 8pm. It will re-open tomorrow at 9.00am with a team of Council officers on hand to offer support and advice to those affected.

Businesses and property owners are encouraged to gain access to premises to determine if they have sustained flood damage, if you are not already aware. If your offices or trading location(s) have been affected, you should contact your property manager or landlord and contact your insurers where necessary.
